Code of Conduct for Young Golfers

As a young golfer taking part in a Middlesex Golf activity, you should:

- Help create and maintain an environment free of fear and harassment
- Demonstrate fair play and apply golf's standards both on and off the course
- Understand that you have the right to be treated as an individual
- Respect the advice that you receive
- Treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself
- Respect other people and their differences
- Look out for yourself and for the welfare of others
- Speak out (to your parents or a county representative) if you consider that you or others have been poorly treated
- Be organised and on time
- Tell the event organiser if you are leaving the venue
- Accept that these guidelines are in place for the well-being of all concerned
- Treat organisers and coaches with respect
- Observe instructions or restrictions requested by the adults looking after you
- Observe local traffic conditions and pay due care & attention when entering or leaving event premises.
